

Security and emails

Users

- Block users by their email address
- Block domain names e.g. all email that ends in @thisisjunk.com
- Set up Safe users - all email from these users is always accepted

Phishing

- Aims to get you to reveal passwords and/or personal info
- Often gives you a link to click on, which leads you to fake websites
- Typically tells you there has been a security risk with your account
- Often asks you to visit a website to change your password
- Sometimes offers you e.g. the latest phone at very very cheap prices

POP3

- Post Office Protocol
- Set up email 'client' on your own computer
- Emails sent to you go first to ISP's email server
- Your client logs in to ISP's email server
- Downloads emails to your computer
- Deletes emails from email server

Junk email

- SPAM**
 - Bulk distribution of an email
 - Usually trying to get you to buy something or visit a website
 - The term SPAM also includes junk mail
- Setting up rules / filters**
 - Set up different levels of blocking
 - Automatically delete junk email
 - Automatically move suspected junk to junk folder
 - Set up rule to deal with email containing specific words
- Reporting junk email to email application provider
- Don't reply to junk emails
- Don't forward junk emails

IMAP

- Internet Message Access Protocol
- Emails stored centrally
- You log in
- Read, manage emails online
- Can access emails from any Internet connection
- Good for teams
